LUPE (Student Services)

- Food Bank
 - Checked out space in food storage space recently
 - Just need to be a lock system for storage, but that wouldn't be a good space for distribution
 - Gathering letters of support from Transportation services
 - Would provide free transport
 - There have been a lot of requests from them, but they've never made exceptions for free services
 - We're trying to get as much support as possible to get that exception
 - Thinking about changing the name to something like AS Pantry

HADAR (Budget and Resources)

- Coordinating Committee on Budget Strategy this Thursday
- Got signatures from professors for SIDE

- Still waiting on Teach the Budget from UCSC

ANTHONY (Sustainability)

- Café
 - Leg Council passed \$250,000 to buy out old business and finalize property sale
 - Will find out in the next couple weeks if we get the property
 - The remaining \$75,000 will go to first year's lease, the rest is left to employees working on it to decide
 - There will be the restaurant on Pardall and the cart will be an extension of that
 - Still have to meet with other committees to finalize
 - Still need an additional \$250,000 to get inventory, furniture, other start-up costs

NADIM (Diversity & Equity)

- CAERS
 - Want to draft a proposal by next week on new policies
 - Agreed on some specifics
 - Including eligibility in local context into entire comprehensive review and giving it a certain amount of weight
