- IV Thought for Food

 - To get anything passed in IV as our own space, we need approval from the UC Regents
 - Still unclear if we need certain levels of approval, but we've been speaking with lawyers at UCOP to see where we stand

 - Need to either renegotiate lease or open it up to other bidders by May 1st
 - 2004 survey: #1 business students want is a café
 - 2010 survey: same results
