OFFICER UPDATES

LUPE (Student Services)

- Student Affairs Student Council
 - Trying to develop a campaign to figure out which student services to consolidate or get rid of because the budget is shrinking
- Student Health Advisory Committee
 - New USHIP Plan coming in September 2011 to include new dental and vision care
 - Would include 2 free cleanings, eye vision exam, and \$120 glasses or contacts for \$200/yr dental and \$37/yr vision
 - Will be through Anthem Insurance and could still be able to get service anywhere outside of Student Health
 - Still being voted on
 - Will include if additional services will be voluntary, mandatory, mandatory dental or vision only
 - ◆ Voluntary took majority (11/13 votes)
 - In the future, may be able to connect all UC Student Healths so all UC students could receive services from any UC Campus
- Food Bank Proposal
 - Updated proposal with additional empirical data was sent out to BCCs for revising
 - Draft will be sent to Business Services this week
- Student Financial/Food Need Survey
 - Still being distributed
 - Hoping to get at least 2,000 responses to legitimize it more

ARMANDO G (Budget and Resources)

- Budget Workshops
 - Still doing research

- Talking to UCSC to get more ideas

ANTHONY (Sustainability)

- New IV Space
 - Leg Council voted on and approved the \$160,000 budget for the current Pardall building
 - Would go towards furniture, beer/liquor license, other permits
 - Will provide a new space for Associated Students located in Isla Vista in order to establish a greater presence in the community
- Fair Trade Policy
 - All food that is purchased through student money and can be fair trade certified must be fair trade certified

STANLEY (Academic Affairs)

- Majors Fair
 - Work with Career Services, departments for each major to get more information, potential jobs, etc.
- CLASS Survey
 - Extended to 20th
 - UCSB leads the survey in responses

EVAN (Public Health)

- Student Health Insurance
 - Dental and Vision will be mandatory, but will be \$200 more a year
 - Gave a lot of suggestions on how to improve the dynamics of Student Health
 - Inefficient, circular system
 - Redefined smoking cessation
 - Get money for patches and gum to quit smoking
 - CASE
 - Trying to make it more meaningful and improve it
 - New Insight Program
 - More individualized, will address the people who tend to slip through the cracks
